**Cpl. Floyd Stewart,
Nazareth, Hurt
In Luxembourg**

Cpl. Floyd T. Stewart, son of Mr. and Mrs. William A. Stewart, 353 South Broad Street, Nazareth, was wounded in action in Luxembourg, according to a War Department telegram received by his parents.

A letter dated March 3 was also received by his parents, in which he states he was injured by shrapnel in the back and was awarded the Purple Heart.

Cpl. Stewart, 21 years old, entered the U. S. Army on April 5, 1943, and was stationed at Camp Campbell, Ky., and Camp Phillips, Kan., before being sent overseas in April, 1944.

He is a graduate of Nazareth High School and prior to entering the service was employed by the Nazareth Steel Fabricators.
