John L. Bealer, 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. William Bealer of 434 Locust Street, Bethlehem, was a member of the eighteenth class of aviation cadets to graduate from the Advanced Twin-Engine Army Flying School, Columbus Army Air Field, Columbus, Miss., today. He received the silver wings of a flying officer and commission as a second lieutenant in the Army Air Forces. Lt. Bealer entered pilot training in March, 1942 and attended flying schools at Albany, Ga. and Cortland, Ala., before his graduation at the advanced flying school near Columbus, Miss.
