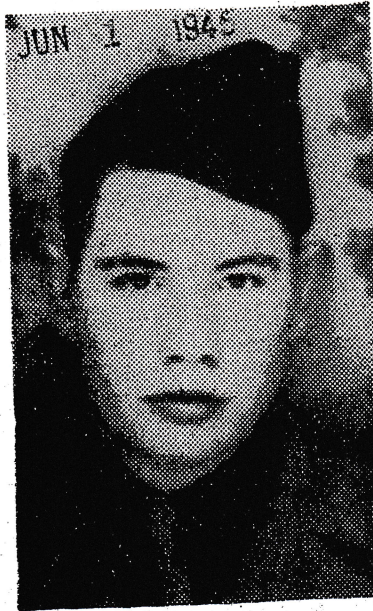


Sandoe Jr, George B.

Reported Dead

Pvt. Sandoe Dies In Action, Parents Learn

A War Department wire received last week reporting that Pvt. George B. Sandoe Jr. was seriously wounded in action April 11 on Okinawa was today corrected in a telegram stating that the boy was killed in action April 9. Regret at the error was expressed.

Pvt. Sandoe, son of Mr. and Mrs. George Sandoe of 49 West Spruce Street, enlisted in the service in November 1943 and at the time of his death was already a veteran of several Philippine engagements. A graduate of Bethlehem Technical High School and a Globe-Times carrier, the young soldier had been awarded the Expert Infantry Badge for "meritorious service." He was a member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, of the American Legion Post 406, and of the drum corps of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.
