To be Discharged**

INDIANTOWN GAP, Pa. —T/5 Clinton U. Hawk, son of Mrs. John E. Hawk R. D. 2, Bath, will be honorably discharged from the Army soon at the Separation Center here after nearly four years of service.

Cpl. Hawk served three years in the European Theater of Operations in a field artillery unit of the 29th Infantry Division and has been awarded the ETO Ribbon with four battle stars, the Arrow Head, the American Defense Ribbon and the Good Conduct Medal.
