Donald F. Fry, former teacher of Latin and English, Fountain Hill Junior High School, has been advanced to the rank of Captain, according to information received by his wife, the former Catherine Hassick, who resides with her parents at 630 Ontario Street.

Overseas for 16 months, Capt. Fry's promotion was effected in New Guinea. Inducted June 5, 1941, he was sent to the Adjutant General School, Fort Washington, Md., from which he was graduated and was sent to Fort Leonard Wood, Mo. From there he went to Yuma, Ariz., and on to Camp San Luis Obispo, Calif., before going overseas.

Capt. Fry is a Liberty High School and Muhlenberg College graduate. Prior to his induction, he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company and taught in Fountain Hill High School. His mother and father, Erwin Fry, well known mail carrier, live at 608 Hoffert Street.
