Pfc. Fritchman Liberated From German Prison

Mrs. Mabel Fritchman of 341 West Fourth Street, yesterday received a letter from her son, Pfc. Charles Fritchman, stating he was a prisoner of war since January in Germany and has now been liberated by the Americans. The last word Mrs. Fritchman had received was a War Department telegram listing him as missing in action as of January 20.

The letter states he is in good health and is glad to be back in Uncle Sam's hands again. He also indicates he expects to be home soon.

Pfc. Fritchman, who entered the service December 5, 1942, was with General Patton's Third Army at the time of his capture. He has been overseas since July, 1944. His wife, the former Janette Bauss, resides in Allentown.

April 19, 1945
