

Anthony, Kenneth F.

Receives Award

Pvt. Kenneth F. Anthony of Nazareth R. D. 3, who was wounded in action in Germany on September 27, has been awarded the Purple Heart. He is now recovering from his wound in the 83rd General Hospital in England. He was wounded in the back by a mortar shell fragment while advancing with his infantry company against the Siegfried line pillboxes.

A brother of the wounded soldier, Sgt. LeRoy Anthony, U. S. Army, was killed in action in the South Pacific.

Pvt. Anthony was formerly employed by the Keystone Dehydrating Company of Nazareth. His wife and son, Mrs. Verna Anthony and Harry, live at Nazareth R. D. 3. Mrs. Ellen Anthony, the soldier's mother, also resides in Nazareth.
