Pfc. Walter R. Rowe Gets Army Discharge After 33 Months

Pfc. Walter R. Rowe, veteran of 33 months overseas duty, was discharged from the U. S. Army June 16, with 104 points to his credit. Pfc. Rowe saw considerable action from the Normandy beachhead, through northern France, Belgium, Holland and the Rhineland. He received the

European-African-Middle Eastern Service and Good Conduct medals. He served with the 29th Division, commanded by Maj. Gen. Gerhardt, from whom he received a certificate of merit honoring him for his duty in the capture of St. Lo, July 18, 1944.

Barbara Anne, daughter of the Rowes, will celebrate her third birthday anniversary at the residence, 108 Vineyard Street, next month. Pfc. Rowe hadn't seen his daughter since she was a few weeks old.
