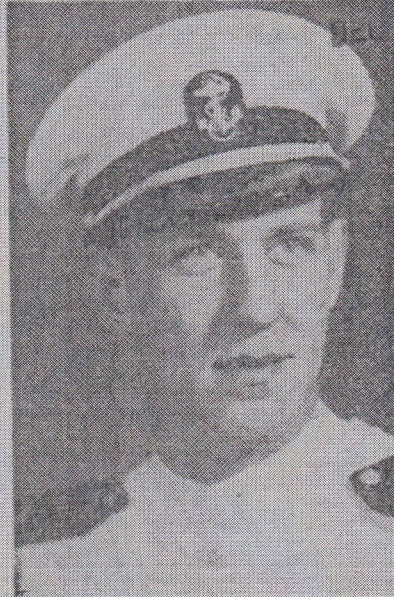


Sigmon, Herman H.
