Bethlehmites Meet In Combat In Africa

To meet in combat somewhere on the North African front friends from whom they had been separated in service, is an interesting experience mentioned in a letter received by Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Morganello, 517 Atlantic Street, this city, from their son, Alfred Morganello, a member of an anti-aircraft regiment.

MAY 31 1943

Morganello tells of having come across John Delgrosso, of Fifth Street, and Steve Brokowics, of Lawfer Avenue, during the engagement halfway round the world from home, and of a happy time the three had along with eight other Bethlehem boys in Morganello's outfit, talking over "the old days back home," especially times spent at Moe's poolroom, now remodeled into a steak restaurant, on East Fourth Street.

The other Bethlehmites who shared in the reunion were Anthony Plaquadio, Dennis Casciano, Albert Crisante, Joseph Morganello, Charles and Stephen Mulicka, Louis Felker and Joseph Geldon.
