Pfc. Franklin Morris Given Discharge

Pfc. Franklin C. Morris, son of Mr. and Mrs. Floyd Morris Nazareth R. D. 2, and husband of Bessie Morris, Twin Spruce Farm, Saylorburg R. D. 1, was honorably discharged from Indiantown Gap Separation Center, February 3.

Entering the Army August 18, 1942, Pfc. Morris received his basic training at Fort Bragg, N. C. He received Military Police training at

Fort George G. Meade, Md., was transferred to Camp Patrick Henry, Va., and served as M.P. for 24 months. Then he served three months at Fort Leonard Wood, Mo., and 10 months at Camp Howze, Tex.
