### Now Air Cadet

Enlisting in Sept., 1942, Gilbert H. Kauffman, son of Mr. and Mrs. Albert H. Kauffman, 315 West Fourth Street, is receiving advanced training for his wings in the U. S. Army Air Corps service. He expects to get his wings as an air pilot shortly. In a letter from his commanding officer to his parents earlier in the week, it was stated that Cadet Gilbert was making fine progress in his training to become a pilot at Randolph Field, Texas.

Shortly after his enlistment Cadet Kauffman left Bethlehem to visit California. While on the Pacific Coast the order came for his induction. He had 30 days time to come East, and after he returned home he was sent to Florida for his basic training.

From Florida he was transferred to Fenn College, Cleveland, Ohio, for a three months' course in pilot instruction. From Cleveland he was sent to Randolph Field for advanced training.

Prior to his enlistment he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company. He is a graduate of Bethlehem High School.
