Jones' Second Son Reported Lost In Action

Word was received last night by A. F. and Florence Gross Jones, of 1421 Chelsea Avenue, of the death of their second son, Pfc. Robert P. Jones, who was killed in action in Germany, February 25. Another son, Lieut. William Jones, was killed in Africa December 9, 1943.

Pfc. Robert Jones entered the service July 10, 1943, and completed his basic training at Camp Shelby, Miss. He was sent to Fort Bragg, N. C., and overseas in October, 1944. He was with the field artillery. The twenty-one-year-old soldier was a graduate of Bethlehem Technical High School.

He is survived by his parents, a sister, Mrs. Marvin Steyers, and a brother, Charles M. Jones, all of Bethlehem.
