Pfc. Daniel Curatola, son of Mr. and Mrs. Carmelo Curatola, 941 Lawler Street, who was wounded June 8 when an enemy mine exploded behind him in Normandy. His parents have been informed of his condition in a letter from a Red Cross nurse which was dictated by Curatola. He says he hopes to be back in action soon.

Private Curatola has seen action in the North African, Sicilian and Normandy campaigns. He has been in service since February 3, 1942. He has two brothers in the service: Pfc. Bruno Curatola with the Marine Air Corps in the South Pacific and Pvt. Anthony Curatola with the Army Air Corps, now stationed in Baltimore.
