

Miller Jr., Lewis S.

**Nazareth Soldier,
Wounded, Cited
For Heroic Action**

Mr. and Mrs. Lewis S. Miller, Sr., 146 North Broad Street, Nazareth, received a message from the War Department that their son, Sgt. Lewis S. Miller, Jr., was slightly wounded in action October 14 in France.

Sgt. Miller was cited for heroic action in combat and received the Bronze Star Medal while he was with the Fifth Army in Italy. He maintained communications with gun emplacements and an observation post by constantly patrolling an 800 yard area under enemy fire.

"Without his untiring efforts, all communications would have been destroyed and a battery of mortars rendered inactive," the citation with the award read.

Sgt. Miller attended Nazareth High School and has been in service for three and a half years.
