West Point.**

Well up among the 410 graduates who will receive commissions at West Point tomorrow is Cadet James A. Aleveras, son of Mr. and Mrs. Anthony Aleveras, of Broadway, Bangor. He is the first West Point graduate from the Slate Belt.

Cadet Aleveras received his diploma from Bangor high school in 1938 after a brilliant athletic and scholastic career. In 1937 he was a member of one of the greatest football teams in Bangor history. He ran the half mile on the track team, and was senior class president. He was also active in dramatics.

He is the second son of Bangor to graduate from the service schools. The other is Lt. Comm. Loring Shook, son of Mr. and Mrs. William Shook, of South Main Street, who is now on active duty with the fleet.
