Wounded in France on June 7, the day after invasion day, the first Bethlehem casualty officially reported from that front, Pfc. William T. Richards Jr., returned home yesterday from England where he has been convalescing in a hospital since June.

After a 21-day furlough spent with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. William T. Richards of 1222 Center Street, Pfc. Richards expects to report to Deschon Hospital in Butler, Pa. The young man, formerly a crane repairman at Bethlehem Steel Company, is the holder of two medals for sharpshooting. He is 22 years old.
