Pvt. Alois Groegler Wounded in France, Reported Improved

Mr. and Mrs. Ignatz Groegler of 716 Hertzog Avenue, Fountain Hill, received a telegram from the War Department on Sunday informing them their nephew, Pvt. Alois Groegler, who resided with them, was wounded in Southern France and is making a normal improvement.

A graduate of Holy Ghost School, Pvt. Groegler was inducted into the armed forces in July, 1943 and received his preliminary training at Fort McClellan, Ala. He was sent overseas in February of this year, landing in Italy.

Prior to his entry into the Army he was employed in the machine shop of the Bethlehem Steel Company.

October 5, 1944
