COMMISSIONED AN OFFICER

—Louis Stephan Cuchran, (above), 29, son of Mr. and Mrs. Michael Cuchran, 591 Selfridge Street, city, telegraphed his parents Thursday night from Fort Sill, Okla., that he has graduated from Officers' Training School and yesterday received his commission as a second lieutenant in Uncle Sam's field artillery. He will be home for a brief furlough Saturday or Sunday and then will go to Camp Shelby, Miss. Lieutenant Cuchran is a graduate of Catholic High, class of '31, and of Muhlenberg College, class of '35, where he studied to be a teacher. He played varsity basketball with the Mules and was interested in other sports. He was inducted into the army on May 8 of this year, promoted to corporal in June and then sent to Officer Candidates' School, from which he just graduated.
