Pfc. John H. Mosko, 27, U. S. Army Infantry, has been reported missing in action since December 24, according to word received recently by his mother, Mrs. Julia Mosko, 907 Evans Street. Mrs. Mosko was notified by the adjutant general's office of the War Department in a telegram.

The young soldier was serving in Northwest Africa at the time the action took place. He attended the city schools and was a member of SS. Cyril and Methodius Church. He would have been in the service just one year this week. He had been overseas for sometime, being stationed in England and Scotland.

A brother, Joseph, 24, is serving with the Air Corps in California. He was home on furlough last week.
