**Pfc. Carl Martin With
Hospital Unit On
Italian Front** APR 11 1945

Pfc. Carl Martin, 716 Wyandotte Street, is now serving in Italy with the 24th General Hospital which has made an impressive record during a year and a half overseas.

For a time the nearest general hospital to the Italian front lines, its patients had more than doubled two weeks after the Anzio landing, and similar increases occurred with the push from Cassino through Rome and Florence. Nevertheless, the death rate had consistently been held to an amazingly low figure.

Pfc. Martin is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Martin. In the seventeen months he has served overseas, he has been awarded the Purple Heart and the Oak Leaf Cluster. Prior to entering the service he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.
