Lieut. Ozimek, who spent a brief leave with his parents and has since returned to duty, is a graduate of Bethlehem High School and prior to his induction into the army January 18, 1941, was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company. His first station was at Fort Sam Houston, Texas, where he remained until November of 1942, during which time he received his ratings as corporal and sergeant. November 29 he was sent to Camp McCoy, Wis., for advanced ski training. He entered Officers Training School at Edgewood January 27 of this year.
