He entered the service in August, 1943, and was assigned to the Army Air Forces. He received his basic training at Keesler Field, Miss., and in California where he trained at a number of air fields. Cpl. Diehl is stationed at Hammer Field, Fresno, Calif. at present. Prior to entering the Army, he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Co.
