Local Marine Wounded In Iwo Invasion

Private First Class Stanley K. Williams Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. Stanley K. Williams Sr., 722 Broadway, has been reported wounded in action in the Pacific Theater of War while taking part in the Iwo Jima invasion. He was wounded February 20, the day following the initial invasion.

Attached to the Fifth Marine Division, Williams completed his boot training at San Diego, Calif., and at Bucknell College. He was transferred to Camp Gillespie for parachute training last December and sent to Oceanside, Calif., where he trained with the Marine Infantry until being sent overseas August, 1944

Pfc. Williams graduated from Bethlehem High School before enlisting in the Marine Corps. No further report has been received as to the extent of his injuries.
