Abstract: The materials in this collection were donated by an employee of the Bethlehem Durkee facility and consists of memoranda, company newsletters, promotional brochures, information regarding the bowling league, recipe books, and company history.

Historical Note: Durkee was founded in 1850 by Eugene R. Durkee, who was selling herbs and spices door to door in Buffalo, NY. In 1957, Durkee moved its location from Long Island City, NY to Bethlehem, PA into the former Roller-Smith plant on Route 378 and 8th Avenue. The Durkee-French spice plant in Bethlehem closed in 1995.

From the donation agreement by Barbara Wiemann: "Material about Durkee Facility in Bethlehem (8th Avenue), 1957-1995. Alfred F. Wiemann worked at Durkee's Plant in Elmhurst (NY) and moved to Bethlehem when production moved to Bethlehem in 1957. Ethel R. Wiemann Anthony worked for Durkee from 1959-1995. Durkee closed its Bethlehem facilities and offices in 1995. Durkee manufactured spices, condiments, coconut, etc."

Scope and Content: The Bethlehem Durkee Facility Records are organized into 5 series. Series 1: Administrative records include memoranda, financial and employee information. Series 2: Employees contains more informal employee information such as a birthday calendar, prize lists, details about the bowling league, and training certificates. Series 3: History details the history of the company and facility in Bethlehem. Series 4: Publications contains cookbooks and brochures published and distributed by Durkee. Series 5: Newsletters, Articles, and Photographs includes Durkee published newsletters, local newspaper articles, and photographs of employees and the facilities.
