Sgt. Fatzinger Arrives On West Coast, Phones

Mrs. James A. Fatzinger, 115 East Packer Ave., formerly of Fountain Hill, received a telephone call from her son Sgt. Lloyd A. Fatzinger upon his arrival on the West Coast.

A veteran of more than a year's overseas duty, he has been in uniform for a year and a half. He trained at military camps in Virginia, Carolina, Georgia, Florida and the State of Washington before shipping to the Hawaiian Islands.

His brother, Sgt. James A. S. Fatzinger, is stationed with a Military Police Battalion in Marseilles, France. He enlisted in the A.S.T.P. August 14, 1943 and trained at Fort McClellan, Ala., and in Georgia before going overseas last year. Sgt. Fatzinger participated in the Battle of the Bulge and was hospitalized for three months in England.

The brothers are graduates of Fountain Hill high school. Mrs. Alice Brish Fatzinger, wife of Lloyd and their daughter, Pamilla Joy, reside at 139 East Broad Street.
