## Reported Safe

Fireman First Class Andrew Sabol Jr., who was aboard the Aircraft Carrier Princeton sunk in the Philippine battle zone, is now reported safe and earning a well earned rest, according to a letter received by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Sabol Sr., 661 Hayes Street.

Inducted July 1, 1943, he volunteered for Navy service and was sent to Sampson, N. Y., to receive his boot training. He then completed a course in Basic Engineering at Great Lakes, Ill., in December, 1943. F 1-C Sabol was sent to Pearl Harbor where he boarded the Princeton on which he served continuously until she was sunk several weeks ago.
