Home After Being
War Prisoner**

Another Bethlehem boy, who was reported missing in action and later a prisoner of war in Germany, Staff Sergeant Harry F. Tachovsky, arrived home today. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Harry Tachovsky of 1 Finady Avenue. His grandfather, Otto Tachovsky, lives at the same address.

The young man, a Liberty High School graduate, class of 1942, holds the Air Medal and four oak leaf clusters. He entered the Air Corps in February 1943, completed his training and was awarded his wings at Keesler Field. A waist gunner on a bomber, he saw active service for 14 months in the Pacific theater.
