T/5 Frank Erney, Zion Hill, a member of the 501st Military Police Battalion which has been formally presented by Major Gen. William M. Grimes with the Meritorious Service Plaque "for outstanding devotion to duty." Cpl. Erney's organization is the first unit of battalion strength in the Antilles Department to receive the award, the highest a service unit may acquire.

Stationed in Puerto Rico for the past 19 months, T/5 Erney is entitled to wear on his uniform an insignia in the form of a gold wreath signifying outstanding personal achievement in his distinguished organization.

He was inducted into the Army July 8, 1943, and received training at Fort Custer, Mich.; left for overseas duty February 14, 1944. Cpl. Erney is married to Mildred Harwick, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Reuben B. Harwick, Zion Hill. He arrived in Zion Hill on furlough September 2.
