Five Area Navy Men Ready For Discharge

Three ships, part of the Navy's 250 carriers, battleships, cruisers, and attack transports in the Magic Carpet Fleet, have docked in California with 5 Bethlehem high-point Navy veterans.

Aboard the USS Shamrock Bay, scheduled to have docked Thursday, was Rudolph J. Preletz, SC 3/c, husband of Mrs. Mary Preletz, 1896 Richmond Avenue. Preletz left Okinawa November 26.

Austin G. Reiman, EM 2/c, U. S. N R., husband of Mrs. Rosemary Reiman, 530 High Street, and Julius Gosztonyi, AM 3/c, USNR, husband of Mrs. B. E. Gosztonyi, 18 West Laurel Street, were brought home aboard the USS Freemont which left Pearl Harbor December 3 and was scheduled to dock in San Francisco Sunday, December 8.

Francis J. Achando, MM 3/c, USN, husband of Mrs. Mary Achando, this city, and Paul Bright, RM 3/c, USNR, son of Mrs. P. E. Bright, 55 East Raspberry Street, were scheduled to arrive in San Diego, December 8 aboard the USS Marcus Island which left Guam November 24.
