ALFRED NAGY TO BEGIN ACTIVE NAVY TRAINING

Moravian College Graduate Will
Study at Notre Dame.

Alfred B. Nagy, son of Mr. and Mrs. William Nagy, of 334 East Broad Street, who was graduated from Moravian College and Theological Seminary Sunday afternoon, will begin active training with the Naval Officers Reserve at Notre Dame University February 1.

Mr. Nagy received a B. A. degree in the major field of history and government. He is a member of Sigma Theta Pi, social fraternity; Alpha Kappa Alpha, national honorary philosophical fraternity, and Pi Delta Epsilon, national honorary journalistic society. During his last year he was president of Pi Delta Epsilon, manager of football, and was one of six Moravian students to have their biographies included in the publication of "Who's Who Among Students in American Colleges and Universities."

In addition Mr. Nagy was editor in his junior year of the college weekly newspaper, The Comenian; at the same time he was chairman of the student-faculty board of publications, and in his senior year he was a member of the student-faculty lecture committee. Among other activities, he sang in the college Glee Club, played clarinet in the college band, was a member of the Archaeology Club in which he was elected president in his sophomore year, and was elected to the Forensic Council, honorary debating society, in his freshman year. He held the office of secretary-treasurer in the honorary Classical Club in his junior year and during his sophomore and junior years was secretary-treasurer of his class.
