LEHIGH VALLEY FOR ALL STATEMENT ON NEGATIVE MAILER IN THE BETHLEHEM MAYORAL RACE

Late last week, Lehigh Valley For All received word that one of our endorsed candidates, Willie Reynolds, had sent out a mailer comparing his primary opponent to Donald Trump. To be clear, Lehigh Valley For All does not condone this behavior. Our organization was founded out of the ashes of the 2016 election and from day one we have rejected the divisive rhetoric and negative campaigning.
