C. S. Jones Jr. Dies in Plane Crash in West

A telegram received this morning by Mr. and Mrs. Charles Jones, of 1201 East Third Street, informed them of the death of their only child, Aviation Radio Mate Third Class, Charles Stephen Jones, Jr.,

killed in a plane crash near San Diego, Calif. No details of the accident were given.

Born in this city on July 15, 1925, he was a son of Charles and Mary (Rigo) Jones. His father is a member of the paid fire department.

A member of the 1943 graduating class of Liberty High School, he was an outstanding athlete. During his second, third and fourth year, he was a member of the football and baseball squads, and in his second and fourth year he was a member of the varsity wrestling team. He represented both the junior and senior classes at assemblies, and was treasurer of the senior class. He was a member of St. John Capistrano's Church.

On April 4, 1943, he enlisted in the naval aviation corps, and following his basic training at Sampson, N. Y., he was subsequently transferred to other bases for advanced training. The body will be shipped to this city for burial.
