Returns To Country As Battle Casualty

Private First Class Nicholas Pastelyak, who has been hospitalized since last May when he received a shrapnel wound in the right thigh in Italy, was recently returned to this country as a casualty.

Recipient of the Purple Heart, Good Conduct Medal and the European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Ribbon, Pfc. Pastelyak spent 10 months overseas as a rifleman with an infantry unit.
