**Bethlehem Soldier  
Becomes Captain  
After Three Years**

Three years ago, June 11, 1941, Kenneth R. Lindner, son of Mrs. George K. Lindner, 432 Montclair Avenue, enlisted in the armed forces. At the age of 23 years, March 13, 1943, he was elevated to a captaincy. His birthday anniversary was celebrated May 18 somewhere in England.

Captain Lindner realized his boyhood dream of a military career by becoming a drum major at the age of 17 while attending a citizens military course at Fort George G. Meade, Md. His Liberty High School days were marked by membership in the band and orchestra. He also played flute and piccolo in the Bethlehem Municipal Band and the Allentown Band, and sang in the choir of St. Peter's Lutheran Church. He was employed as a craneman at the Bethlehem Steel Company.
