Staff Sergeant Herman J. Seigfeldt, 29, returned from service outside the continental United States, now is being processed at Army Air Forces Redistribution Station No. 2, Miami Beach, Fla., where his next assignment will be determined.

Sergeant Seigfeldt's parents, formerly of Bethlehem, are with him in Miami. The young gunner had been in England, Africa and the Middle East for 27 months and flew on 25 missions. He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross with one cluster and the Air Medal with three clusters.
