Honorably Discharged After Long Service

After serving 33 months, Cpl. John J. Pallarico, 22, of 833 Linden Street, was honorably discharged from the Army at the Newark Separation Base.

He came there for discharge from Miami Army Air Field where he served temporarily at that important base of the Caribbean Wing Air Transport Command.

Prior to his duty at Miami Army Air Field, he served 22 months overseas with the 61st Troop Carrier group in the ETO. The son of Patsy Pallarico, he was a student at Liberty High School before donning Uncle Sam's khaki. The Corporal wears the ETO ribbon with 5 battle stars, ATO ribbon, Good Conduct Medal and the Presidential Unit Citation ribbon.
