Bethlehem Air Hero Broadcasts From Holland

Hero in one of the greatest aerial dogfights in history, Lieut. Col. Robert P. Montgomery, 1953 Eaton Avenue, spoke last evening from somewhere in Holland over radio station WOR.

The young hero is credited with shooting down three Nazi planes on November 2 in a battle over Germany. Last March Col. Montgomery was shot down in occupied France and was able to return to American lines after D-Day.

Subsequently an "R and R" (Rest and Recreation at home) was given Col. Montgomery by the Eighth Army Air Force. He spent the time

with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. John L. Montgomery of Eaton Avenue. In a few weeks he was back in action, ready for more.
