## Local Family Gets Memorial From College

Honoring their son, First Lt. Dale S. Chamberlin, U. S. Marine Corps, a memorial presented by the University of Michigan has been received by Mr. and Mrs. Dale S. Chamberlin, 804 West Market Street, this city.

Lieutenant Chamberlin, who was killed in action on the Island of Tinian (Marianna Group) November 3, 1944, received an A.B. degree from the University in 1942. The memorial says:

### Dale S. Chamberlin

The University of Michigan has placed this name upon the roll of those students and alumni who, in the fine tradition of loyalty and self-sacrifice established by former generations, served their country in time of peril and have given their lives in defense of our national liberties. It will forever be held in honor. To the family and friends who have suffered bereavement, the Regents and faculties of the University offer their deepest sympathy.

It is signed by Alexander G. Ruthven, president; and Shirley W. Smith, secretary.

Thus far 217 have given their lives and the University has sent these memorials to their families.
