Sgt. Balogh, who enlisted in January, 1942, is a pilot with the Army Air Corps, and was with the first troop to arrive in Australia. He became friendly with an Australian pilot and in December took this pilot's sister, Miss Joyce Etherton, daughter of Judge and Mrs. Lawlor Etherton, of Brisbane, Australia, as his bride.

At the present time Sgt. Balogh is stationed somewhere in New Guinea. He has received two citations.
