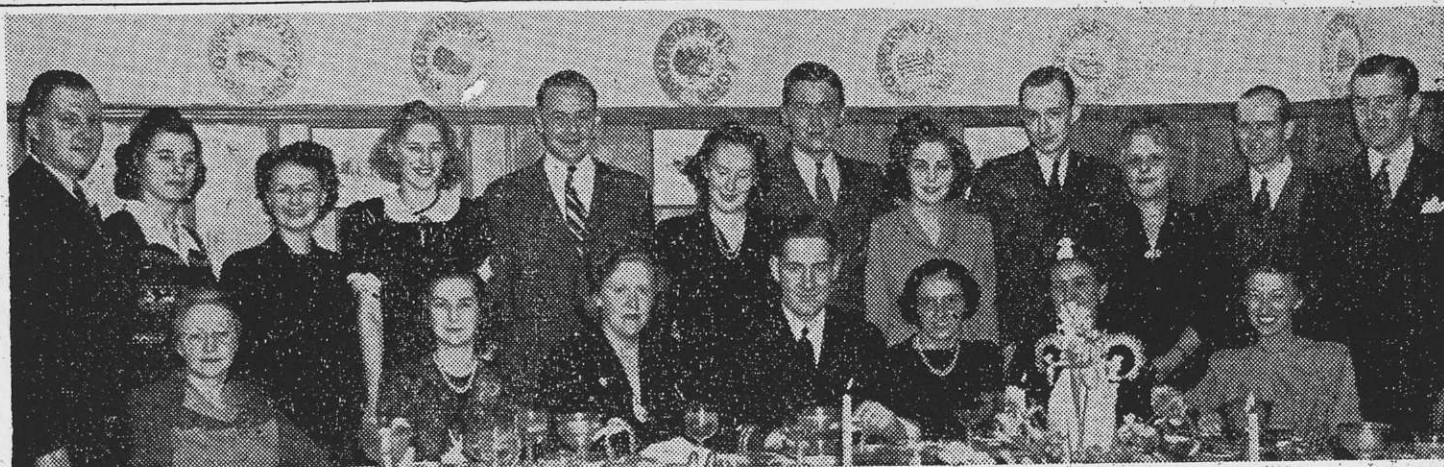

February 23.
