Sergeant Robert R. Anderson, Northampton, has "bought himself a piece of the Air Force." He was among the first soldiers stationed in England, to make a purchase in the war bond campaign staged by the Eighth Air Force to buy a "Victory Squadron." All planes flown by the Eighth will be represented in the Victory Squadron, and each officer and enlisted man buying bonds in the drive becomes a "shareholder."

Anderson, a fighter squadron duty sergeant, formerly resided at 1659 Washington Avenue.
