**Major Francis Murray
Commended for Duty
As Control Officer**

BALTIMORE—Major Francis A. Murray Jr., 266 Tenth Ave., Bethlehem, has been awarded the Army Commendation Ribbon in special ceremonies conducted by Major General Manton S. Eddy, commanding general of the Third Service Command.

The citation recognizes outstanding performance of duty by Major Murray as control officer, Headquarters, Third Service Command, from March to June, 1946.

Major Murray graduated from Lehigh University and was associated with Certainteed Products Corporation before entering the Army in 1941. He was commissioned at Fort Belvoir, Va., in May 1942.

He served at Fort Belvoir, Camp Reynolds and Indiantown Gap Military Reservation in Pennsylvania before coming to Service Command headquarters early this year.

His citation reads in part: "His positive actions in maintaining high standards of performance in the functioning of his office, and in effecting improvements, elimination, consolidation and economies in procedures, forms, reports and work progress generally were of great value in the administration of the command in the transition from war to post-war missions."
