Private First Class John R. Parker was wounded in action February 11 in Germany, his mother, Mrs. Alice Cless, 324 Carbon Street, was informed in a War Department telegram. He trained at Camp Wheeler, Ga.; Helena, Mont., and Upton, N. Y., before going overseas December 29, 1944. Prior to induction he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.
