After European Duty**

Pvt. Alex Poczak, 47 Clearfield Street, Freemansburg, son of Mrs. Theresa Poczak, returned home on a 30-day furlough yesterday after seven months service overseas. He has been in service three years and wears three battle stars for participating in European warfare.

Pvt. Poczak has two brothers in service. Sgt. William Poczak is serving with the military police in Paris, having recovered from serious wounds suffered in battle, and Seaman Russell Poczak is with a fleet aircarrier in the South Pacific.

A brother-in-law, Fred A. Mann, husband of Mary Poczak, is also stationed in the South Pacific and recently met Seaman Russell at a South Pacific base, according to letters received by the family.
