T/Sgt. Forrest H. Taylor, who was returned to the States from Germany two days ago, was honorably discharged yesterday at Indianatown Gap Military Reservation.

The son of Mr. and Mrs. Warren Taylor, 1202 North New Street., he has been in uniform for three years with the 75th Infantry Regiment. He shipped overseas in October, 1944, and participated in the Battle of the Bulge, in which he was transferred to the 8th Airborne Division and sent to Germany, where he had been stationed for the past several months.
