Private Dale Groman, son of Mr. and Mrs. Edwin Groman, 68 East Garrison Street, was reported wounded in action November 9, 1944, in France in a War Department telegram. Pvt. Groman was awarded the Purple Heart and has since returned to the front, his parents were informed. He was inducted January 18, 1943 and received basic training at Camp Blanding, Fla., before leaving for overseas duty in Italy, July 1.
