**Radio Program
Brings News Of
War Prisoner**

Pvt. Harry Balogh, husband of the former Emma Zapp, 511 Chew Street, Allentown, and son of Mrs. Mary Balogh, of Miller Heights, is now a prisoner of war in Germany. Warren Brooks of 130 American Street, Fullerton, was listening to a short wave radio on Sunday evening and an American woman in charge of the program interviewed three prisoners in Germany. Pvt. Balogh while being interviewed said he was taken prisoner Sept. 13, was uninjured, in good health and asked that listeners to communicate with his wife at the Allentown address and tell her his address which now is Stalag 3B Germany, Commando USA-5. He also stated that he mailed Christmas greetings to his folks back home.

A resident of Alabama, who also heard this communication called Mrs. Balogh by telephone after the broadcast. This man's son is also a prisoner of war and he listens continually to the short wave programs in hopes of hearing something about his own son.
