Given Citation

Staff Sergeant Daniel R. Morrison, son of Mrs. Gertrude Morrison, 706 Seventh Avenue, was cited for gallantry in action in Leyte, Philippine Islands, December 13, 1944.

The citation read, "During an engagement with the enemy, the commander of the company of which Staff Sergeant Morrison was a member was seriously wounded and lying in an exposed position near the enemy. With utter disregard for his own safety, Staff Sergeant Morrison moved forward in the face of heavy hostile machine gun and rifle fire and carried the wounded officer to safety. His heroic action was an inspiration to his unit and is in keeping with the highest tradition of the military service."
