Pfc. Hayes Missing Since Christmas Day

Pfc. Albert T. Hayes has been missing in action in the European area since December 25, according to a telegram from the War Department received by his wife, Mrs. Dorothy Hayes, 427 North Seventh Street, Allentown. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Hayes, 123 East Garrison Street, this city.

Pfc. Hayes was inducted into the armed forces June 15, 1944, and received training at Sheppard Field, Tex., and Camp Rucker, Ala., before going overseas during the week of November 18, 1944.

Prior to induction he was employed by Bethlehem Steel Company as assistant shipper in the Lehigh merchant mills. He is a member of Emmanuel Evangelical Church. The Hayes have one daughter, Joy, aged two years.
